Between Vila Nova de Famalicão and Santo Tirso, Caldas da Saúde, or Caldinhas, is a pleasant and extremely peaceful spot where the priests of the Order of Santo Inácio de Loyola still stroll.

The property and spa facilities were acquired by the Companhia de Jesus in 1932, following the transfer to Portugal of the Jesuit College until then installed in La Guardia, Spain.

Nearby is S. Miguel de Seide, where Camilo Castelo Branco, one of the most celebrated Portuguese novelists of the 19th century lived and died.
