Located to the north of the imposing Nazaré Promontory [Promontório da Nazaré], better known as "Sítio", Praia do Norte is not a supervised beach and its feel is a little wild, with dunes that preserve the original vegetation. The rough sea

Praia da Comporta

Beaches

Address: Grândola

Located on the southern tip of the Tróia Peninsula, the huge sandy extent of Comporta Beach is a regular summer favourite, given good means of access and plenty of parking space. Forming part of the Sado Estuary Nature Reserve, Comporta Beach has

Praia do Carvalhal

Beaches

Address: Lagoa Formosa - Grândola

With good access via a tarmac road leading through fields of rice paddies giving way to pine trees, the huge sandy expanse of Carvalhal Beach is surrounded by dunes and bathed by a calm sea. With its support infrastructures and good car parking, this

Praia do Pego

Beaches

Address: Carvalhal - Grândola

With its gentle sea, spacious sands and white dunes, the Pego Beach is a picture of tranquillity. A southwards running continuation of Carvalhal Beach, Pego Beach may be reached via the same road but has its own services and restaurant. This beach

Melides

Praia da Aberta Nova

Beaches

Address: Fontainhas do Mar - Grândola

The Aberta Nova Beach is nature at its purest. Indeed, the large expanse of this Beach has survived broadly untouched by human activity even while there is a lifeguard and a café. Considered one of the best beaches in the region, the Aberta Nova

Praia da Galé - Fontainhas

Beaches

Address: Grândola

With its fossil laden cliff featuring formations that date back around five million years, Galé-Fontainhas Beach provides a stunning landscape with a different kind of beauty to the other beaches in the north of Grândola council, generally

Praia de Melides

Beaches

Address: Grândola

Melides Beach is composed of the long stretch of sand that separates the sea and Melides Lagoon. Both access by road and the car parking are of good standard and this beach can be enjoyed with the back up of a full range of support infrastructures,

Mértola

Praia fluvial da Tapada Grande

Beaches

Address: Albufeira da Barragem da Tapada Grande - Mértola

Located in the peaceful environment of the Tapada Grande Dam reservoir, the river beach of the same name is a very pleasant leisure area, with sand, grassed areas and a full support infrastructure. Close by is the village of Minas de São Domingos,

Praia de Almogrove

Beaches

Address: Odemira

Part of the Sudoeste Alentejano e Costa Vicentina Natural Park, Almogrove Beach is one of the best beaches along this rocky, coastline with its many inlets. In addition to the broad sands surrounded by reddish cliffs and dunes, there are support

Porto Covo

Praia da Ilha do Pessegueiro

Beaches

Address: Porto Covo - Sines

The Ilha do Pessegueiro Beach lies facing the island from which it takes its name. The island has given up evidence of its long history having been settled back in ancient time. This include a fish salting factory dating to the Roman era and which

Praia do Salto

Beaches

Address: Sines

Located alongside the Praia Grande de Porto Covo Beach, Salto Beach is smaller but able to provide an ambience of privacy and peacefulness given its many coves. Since 2002, the Beach has joined the limited number of officially recognised naturist

Praia da Samouqueira

Beaches

Address: Porto Covo - Sines

Samouqueira Beach is the last in a series of sandy stretches to be found among the rocks, difficult to reach but of great natural beauty, including the Vieirinha, Oliveirinha, Foz and Burrinho beaches. Surrounded by cliffs, but easier to access

Praia dos Aivados

Address: Sines

The extremely long sandy extent of great untamed natural beauty that makes up Aivados Beach is understandably part of the Sudoeste Alentejano e Costa Vicentina Natural Park, given that the surrounding area contains a diverse range of vegetation that

Santiago do Cacém

Praia da Costa de Santo André

Beaches

Address: Santiago do Cacém

Right by Santo André Lagoon, and part of a Nature Reserve, the Costa de Santo André Beach is a long stretch of sand with the Atlantic Ocean on one side and the calm waters of the lagoon on the other. Surrounded by golden dunes, this beach with its

Praia da Fonte do Cortiço

Address: Santiago do Cacém

A huge expanse of sand flanked by dunes, the Fonte do Cortiço Beach is one of the most attractive in the region. While the force of the waves and sea here needs to be treated with some respect, the Beach provides long, wonderful strolls along the

Praia Grande de Porto Covo

Beaches

Address: Sines

Part of the Sudoeste Alentejano e Costa Vicentina Natural Park, Porto Covo was a small fishing village that prospered during the 20th century while holding onto all the quiet charm of its rows of immaculately whitewashed houses against which the sea

Praia Vasco da Gama

Beaches

Address: Sines

Within the city limits of Sines and the scene of major events in Portuguese history, Vasco da Gama Beach is in a sheltered bay with practically no waves and thus ideal for windsurfing and sailing. Flanked by the Avenida Marginal coast-road, very

Praia da Costa do Norte

Beaches

Address: Sines

Located immediately to the north of the Sines Cape, the Costa do Norte Beach is the first on the kilometres and kilometres of sand stretching all the way to the Tróia peninsula. Due to the currents and dangerous depths of the sea here, this Beach

Praia de Morgavel

Beaches

Address: Sines

Surrounded by a tight ring of dunes, Morgavel Beach extends over a long stretch of sand bathed by clear waters considered to be the cleanest on the Alentejo coastline. With excellent access via a tarmac road and good car parking, this is one of the

Praia de São Torpes

Beaches

Address: Sines

Its strong and regular waves ensure São Torpes Beach is one of the best for surfing to be found along the entire extent of the Portuguese coastline with a number of schools available for those wishing to learn this sport. Located right in the

Praia de Vale Figueiros

Beaches

Address: Sines

Also called Vieirinha or Pedra da Casca, Vale de Figueiros Beach has a wide stretch of sand bathed by strong waves that are much appreciated by surfers and bodyboarders. This beach is part of the Sudoeste Alentejano and Costa Vicentina Natural Park,

Praia Atlântica (Soltroia)

Address: Troia - Grândola

Forming part of the Troia Peninsula, the Atlântica Beach is bordered by white sand dunes and the calm, clear sea. Sunbathers may also be lucky enough to spot a school of dolphins swimming just off the coast. Next to the beach, which features a full

Praia de Troia Mar

Address: Troia - Grândola

Located on the Atlantic Ocean side of the Troia Peninsula, Troia-Mar Beach boasts stunning views looking out over the Serra da Arrábida hills right in front. This is an easy beach to get to with the nearby tourist developments served by road and a

Address: Vila Nova de Milfontes - Odemira

Right by Vila Nova Milfontes, one of the most popular resorts on the Alentejan coastline, Franquia Beach is separated from the adjoining Farol Beach by a rocky outcrop. This river beach provides the ideal water conditions for children, as well as,

Praia do Farol - Vila Nova de Milfontes

Beaches

Address: Vila Nova de Milfontes

With the River Mira on one side and the ocean on the other, Farol Beach is in Vila Nova de Milfontes, right beside Franquia Beach, from which it is separated by a rocky formation. Like at Furnas Beach, pools are formed at low tide that are sure to

Zambujeira do Mar

Praia da Zambujeira do Mar

Beaches

Address: Odemira

Part of the Costa Vicentina e Sudoeste Alentejano Natural Park, Zambujeira do Mar Beach is surrounded by tall cliffs that offer wonderful panoramic views out over the ocean. The frequently strong waves breaking on this beach provide quality

Praia do Carvalho - São Teotónio

Beaches

Address: Odemira

To be found just a few kilometres on from Zambujeira do Mar and accessed via a dirt track beginning just to its south, Carvalho Beach is a popular summer favourite. Part of the Sudoeste Alentejano e Costa Vicentina Natural Park, and an equally well

Praia do Bico das Lulas (Troia)

Beaches

Address: Troia - Grândola

The Bico das Lulas is another of the Troia Peninsula's many beaches endowed with fine sands and calm, almost wave-free waters. Its sands lead onto dunes and support infrastructures including volleyball courts and football and rugby pitches.

Praia das Furnas - Milfontes

Beaches

Address: Vila Nova de Milfontes - Odemira

To be found on the left bank of the River Mira near Vila Nova de Milfontes, Furnas Beach is a river beach with a strong sea influence. Throughout low tide, the beach extends beyond the mouth of the Mira with small sandy coves forming among the

Praia do Malhão

Beaches

Address: Odemira

This huge sandy beach is generally known as Malhão Beach even while it is made up of Cruz, Saltinho, Nascedios and Galés beaches, with differing points of access and characteristics. Falling within the protected beauty of the Sudoeste Alentejano e

Praia do Brejão ou da Amália

Beaches

Address: Odemira

Part of the Sudoeste Alentejano e Costa Vicentina Natural Park, Brejão Beach is also known as Amália's Beach due to the house belonging to the famous fado singer Amália Rodrigues who used to spend long vacations here. A site of great natural

Praia dos Alteirinhos

Beaches

Address: Odemira

Accessed by a dirt track beginning just south of Zambujeira do Mar, in the heart of the Sudoeste Alentejano e Costa Vicentina Natural Park, Alteirinhos Beach is peaceful with fine, golden sands. Sheltered from the prevailing winds by a tall cliff,

Algarve

Albufeira

Praia Manuel Lourenço

Beaches

Address: Galé - Albufeira

Surrounded by golden cliffs covered in vegetation, Manuel Lourenço Beach is accessed via Galé, its neighbour. With good services and facilities, the well-preserved natural surroundings of this Beach feature a fairly varied and balanced ecosystem.

Praia da Coelha

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Nestling between golden coloured cliffs, Coelha Beach is small and sheltered from breezes, with the sea gently lapping at the shore. Located about 5 kilometres to the west of Albufeira, it tends to be relatively busy during the summer season.

Praia da Galé

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

In order to differentiate between means of accesses originating at the car park, the long stretch of sand making up Galé Beach is divided into two, named after their respective locations - East and West. Surrounded by golden cliffs, Galé Beach is

Praia da Rocha Baixinha

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Popularly known as "Praia dos Tomates" (Tomato Beach) given the plants growing by one of the points of access, Rocha Baixinha Beach is a peaceful area in the far east of the long Falésia Beach and a favourite destination for many of Portugal's

Praia de São Rafael

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Owing its name to the nearby tourist resort, São Rafael Beach is flanked by cliffs with its sands dotted with a few isolated rocks with more jutting out of the sea to create a very picturesque effect. With excellent conditions and a good range of

Praia Maria Luísa

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

With access from the Olhos de Água village or the Quinta da Balaia tourist resort, the Maria Luísa Beach is characterised by the surrounding cliffs with their tones of ochre through to gold contrasting with the blue of the sea. The beach has a full

Praia da Falésia - Açoteias / Alfamar

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

With its backdrop made up of a long cliff coloured in hues of red, copper and gold, and of particular beauty as the afternoon draws to a close, this far-reaching extent of sand covers the kilometres between Olhos de Água and Vilamoura incorporating

Praia da Oura

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Very close to Albufeira, and right in the heart of one of the Algarve's most popular areas, the Oura Beach has all every aspect necessary for some wonderful holidays down by the sea. The sea is calm and ideal for relaxation or sports such as

Praia de Santa Eulália

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

With its surrounding golden cliffs covered with pine trees and gardens, the charming Santa Eulália Beach is one of the most beautiful and best cared for on the entire Algarve coast. The beach is next to a leisure complex that provides a bar,

Praia do Barranco das Belharucas

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

The Barranco das Belharucas Beach is to be found at the westward end of Falésia Beach (which extends over kilometres eastwards as far as Vilamoura), and is separated from Olhos de Água by rocks that may be skirted round at low tide. Its odd name

Praia do Castelo - Guia

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Very small and welcoming, Castelo Beach is enclosed by large rocks in curious formations with one such display at the eastern end of the beach forming a castle shape, hence the Beach's name. Located just a few kilometres from Albufeira, the Beach

Praia do Inatel

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Situated in Albufeira next to the hotel complex that gives it its name, INATEL beach is very popular and lively. Golden sand, clear warm waters and full support facilities are the guaranteed attractions for a good time spent at leisure and relaxing.

Praia dos Arrifes

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Situated to the west of Albufeira, Praia dos Arrifes is one of the smallest beaches in the municipality. This small cove is sheltered from the wind by low, interestingly shaped cliffs where one can see some potholes, which are typical of this

Praia dos Olhos de Água

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Traditionally a small fishing village, Olhos de Água (Eyes of Water) gets its name due to the freshwater springs to be found among the rocks at the eastern end of the beach. At low tide, it is very easy to spot them bubbling up through the sand and

Praia dos Salgados

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Covering a large area, Salgados Beach contrasts with the other beaches of Albufeira due its diversity of landscape. Here, the backdrop of ochre cliffs gives way to a cordon of golden dunes. Beyond the dunes is the Salgados Lagoon, an important

Alcoutim

Praia fluvial do Pego Fundo

Beaches

Address: Alcoutim

Located close to Alcoutim, in inland Algarve, Pego Fundo River Beach is a very pleasant space, surrounded by lush vegetation. This bathing area, fed by Ribeira de Cadavais, has calm waters and full amenities that include a garden, a volleyball field

Praia do Evaristo

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Very small and huddled between truncated spurs, Evaristo Beach owes its name to the famous restaurant to be found here. With access gained via the village of Galé, this Beach is an excellent choice for holidaymakers and attracts many of the most

Praia do Túnel ou Peneco

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

With access via a tunnel connecting with the city centre, Peneco or Túnel Beach is located at the long stretch of sand running the length of Albufeira. At the far west of the beach, there is a promenade perfect for a pleasant stroll and providing

Praia dos Aveiros

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Fairly small and surrounded by cliffs, Aveiros Beach is a friendly environment with excellent diving conditions. Adjoining Oura Beach, the major recreational centre on this stretch of the coast, Aveiros Beach is reached via the stairway next to

Praia dos Pescadores

Beaches

Address: Albufeira

Located right in the centre of the long sandy extent running the length of Albufeira, Pescadores Beach has retained the picturesque ambience created by the colourful traditional fishing vessels that are normally drawn up over on the east of this

Aljezur

Praia da Amoreira

Beaches

Address: Aljezur

This huge beach is flanked by dunes and to the north by a dark rock formation that, according to locals, forms the shape of a giant lying down. As Amoreira Beach lies on the mouth of a small river there is the option between freshwater or saltwater

Praia da Bordeira ou Carrapateira

Beaches

Address: Aljezur

Nearby the village of Carrapateira from where access is gained via a tarmac road, the wonderful Bordeira Beach extends over a broad stretch of sand that becomes one of the largest on the Algarve coast during low tide. A small river reaches the sea

Praia de Vale Figueiras

Beaches

Address: Aljezur

With access rendered somewhat difficult along an earth track, the attractive Vale Figueiras beach has remained somewhat beyond the normal destinations of sunbathers. However, it is well known to the surfing and bodyboarding communities and is now

Praia do Monte Clérigo

Beaches

Address: Aljezur

Located next to the fishing village of Monte Clérigo, this similarly named Beach lies around 10 kilometres from the town of Aljezur with easy access via the tarmac road leading to the ramps and stairways down to the beach itself. The spacious

Armação de Pêra

Praia Grande

Beaches

Address: Pera - Silves

The area known as Praia Grande Beach begins at the urban limits of Armação de Pêra, with its westerly point at the Alcantarilha stream and its easterly limit defined by the Salgados lagoon, a site of special ecological interest given its

Praia da Arrifana

Beaches

Address: Aljezur

Located in a bay enclosed by tall cliffs and with local residences harmoniously sloping down almost to the water's edge, Arrifana Beach provides an excellent example of balance between human settlement and the natural environment. The ruins of the

Praia de Odeceixe

Beaches

Address: Aljezur

On the mouth of the Seixe River, itself good for boat and canoeing excursions, Odeceixe Beach offers both sea and river swimming. At low tide, the large sandy surface is dotted with lagoons, ideal for children to play and swim in. With the easiest

Praia do Amado

Beaches

Address: Aljezur

Considered one of Portugal's best surfing beach, Amado Beach brings them in from across Europe and regularly hosts international competitions. However, it is not just the more experienced out on the water, there are surfing school for those wishing

Praia do Vale dos Homens

Beaches

Address: Aljezur

Aljezur represents the perfect base from which to set off and explore the marvellous beaches of the western Algarve including Vale dos Homens, a true oasis of calm and beauty. Closed off to both the north and south by tall cliffs, the Beach is off

Praia de Armação de Pera

Beaches

Address: Armação de Pera - Silves

Formerly a small fishing village, Armação de Pêra has now become one of the most popular resorts on the Algarve with every form of entertainment and recreation. In the old part of the city, the charm of the traditional squat fisherman's houses

Castro Marim

Praia Verde

Beaches

Address: Castro Marim

A huge, flat expanse of sand that continues endlessly in either direction be it eastwards or westwards, Verde Beach is a picture postcard of tranquillity. The calm of the sea and the pleasing air and sea temperatures only serve to improve the

Praia do Cabeço / Retur

Beaches

Address: Castro Marim

The Cabeço Beach, also known as Retur given the nearby tourist resort, lies in the eastern Algarve, around 6 kilometres from Castro Marim. This impressive, unbroken stretch of sand runs for large distances in either direction with the neighbouring

Faro

Praia da Ilha da Barreta / Ilha Deserta

Beaches

Address: Ria Formosa - Faro

The mostly southerly point of the Portuguese mainland, the Ilha da Barreta or Deserta is one of the island-barriers of the Ria Formosa Natural Park forming a divide between the marshes and the sea. Accessible only via ferry service (available

Praia da Ilha de Faro

Beaches

Address: Ria Formosa - Faro

For those arriving from the west, Ilha de Faro is the first island-barrier that separates the sea from the Ria Formosa estuary marking the beginning of the Natural Park. Accessible by car over the narrow bridge that connects with the main road to

Lagoa

Praia Grande - Ferragudo

Beaches

Address: Ferragudo - Lagoa

With its white houses reaching down to the banks of the Arade river, Ferragudo is a picturesque fishing village located opposite Portimão with which it once shared responsibility for defending this stretch of coastline. This was secured by

Praia da Marinha

Beaches

Address: Caramujeira - Lagoa

Backed by a tall cliff sculptured by the effects of erosion, the beauty of Marinha Beach has been ranked as among the top 100 worldwide and given its well-preserved natural environment the Beach has retained practically its original state. Before

Praia da Alagoa

Beaches

Address: Altura Castro Marim

Right by Altura, with its squat houses laid out along perpendicular streets over the plain, the Alagoa Beach, also known as Altura, takes up a section of the endless sands that head out eastwards towards Monte Gordo and westwards to the Ria Formosa

Praia da Ilha da Culatra

Beaches

Address: Ria Formosa - Faro

Part of the Ria Formosa Natural Park, the Ilha da Culatra is one of the island-barriers separating the sea from the estuary. Accessible only by the ferry service departing from Olhão, the Beach is free of any motorised vehicles ensuring peace and

Praia da Ilha do Farol

Beaches

Address: Ria Formosa - Faro

Accessible via regular ferry service departing from Faro, the island of Farol is one of those forming the sandy barrier between the sea and the Ria Formosa estuary and forms part of the Natural Park. The small village of Farol is home mostly to

Praia da Cova Redonda - Porches

Beaches

Address: Porches - Lagoa

Considered one of the most beautiful beaches in Europe, Cova Redonda Beach has small patches of sand scattered amongst rock formations carved out by erosion. The beach is surrounded by high cliffs and lies to the east of Senhora da Rocha Beach, with

Praia da Senhora da Rocha

Beaches

Address: Porches - Lagoa

Set back between tall cliffs, Senhora da Rocha Beach is a small area of sand with a calm and clear sea, ideal for both swimming or as a departure point for boat excursions along the coast to discover the nearby grottoes. To the west, the beach ends

Praia de Albandeira

Beaches

Address: Benagil - Lagoa

With its excellent surfing waves, Albandeira Beach is a small shell of sand surrounded by truncated cliff faces creating highly unusual formations.

Praia de Vale Covo

Beaches

Address: Carvoeiro - Lagoa

Backed by a high cliff on which sits the Hotel Tivoli Almansor, the Vale Covo Beach is a small cove of stunning beauty. Accessed down a staircase, this is a very sheltered Beach complete with clear and calm seas that are excellent for diving, an

Praia do Pintadinho

Beaches

Address: Ferragudo - Lagoa

Near Ferragudo, the Pintadinho Beach is reasonably sized and enjoys calm and danger-free seawaters. Surrounded by cliffs that ensure shelter, this beach offers good panoramic views out over the city of Portimão.

Praia do Vale do Olival - Alporchinhos

Beaches

Address: Alporchinhos - Porches - Lagoa

Situated at the western end of Armação de Pera Beach, Vale do Olival Beach nestles between some rock formations carved out by erosion. The cliff that surrounds it has a trail that offers magnificent views of the sea and connects with the nearby

Lagos

Meia Praia

Beaches

Address: Lagos

One of the most famous of the Lagos region, Meia Praia runs over some 5 kilometres of sand between the Marina and the Alvor estuary, with the eastern extent known as São Roque Beach. In addition to being near the railway station, this Beach has

Praia da Luz

Beaches

Address: Lagos

A fishing community since the earliest human settlement of this area, Luz has gone on to become a highly popular summer destination while holding onto its original charm. The easily accessed Beach has excellent support infrastructures including the

Praia de Benagil

Beaches

Address: Benagil - Lagoa

With fishing boats practically hiding its small area of sand, Benagil Beach is located on one of the prettiest stretches of Algarve coastline, with its truncated cliffs and spurs forming grottoes and caverns. With its calm sea, this area is ideal

Praia do Carvoeiro

Beaches

Address: Carvoeiro - Lagoa

Next to a cliff on which harmoniously stand small white fishermen's houses, Carvoeiro Beach is an attractive and picturesque landmark of the Algarve. Its limited extent of sand is highly popular with bathers who take up positions next to fishing

Praia do Vale de Centeanes

Beaches

Address: Carvoeiro - Lagoa

Sheltered by golden cliffs with their odd formations eroded backwards sometimes forming grottoes, the Vale de Centeanes Beach is a pretty cove reached down a long stairway. The clear and calm waters of the beach encourage long swims.

Praia dos Caneiros

Beaches

Address: Ferragudo - Lagoa

Located about 3 kilometres from the town of Ferragudo, Caneiros Beach is a peaceful area surrounded by cliffs of great natural beauty creating an ambience propitious to rest and relaxation.

Praia da Batata

Beaches

Address: Lagos

Literally just a few metres from the historic centre of the city of Lagos, the friendly Batata Beach is perfect for anyone who likes their beach along with plenty of company. With top-quality support infrastructures, there is every kind of

Praia de Dona Ana

Beaches

Address: Lagos

Sheltered between cliffs, the sands of Dona Ana Beach and their calm and clear waters are one of the highest profile landmarks on the Algarve. The highly shaped rocks emerging from the sea or dotting the sands provide sunbathers with some shade and

Praia de Porto de Mós

Beaches

Address: Lagos

Surrounded by tall cliffs, the charming Porto de Mós Beach rolls out like a long tongue of golden sand reaching down to the calm sea with its waters in ever changing tones of blues and greens. Walking westwards along the cliff takes you to the

Praia dos Pinheiros

Beaches

Address: Lagos

Praia da Ribeira d'Ilhas

Address: Ericeira - Mafra

Located around 3.5 kilometres from Ericeira and right by the river mouth that provides its name, Ribeira d' Ilhas Beach is considered one of the best in Europe for both surfing and bodyboarding. Since 1985, it has annually hosted one of the world

Praia de São Lourenço

Beaches

Address: Ericeira - Mafra

Lying 7 kilometres from Ericeira and in close proximity to Ribamar, it is famous for its many quality restaurants specialising in fresh fish and shellfish. São Lourenço Beach is located in a sheltered bay and equipped with good support

Praia do Norte / Algodio (Ericeira)

Beaches

Address: Ericeira - Mafra

Also known as Algodio Beach, Norte Beach lies within the town and is defined by the Ericeira jetty. With access from the centre of town, this is one of the busiest beaches in the region and attracts a very diversified group of regulars.

Praia dos Coxos

Address: Ribamar - Ericeira

Small but very enjoyable, Coxos Beach is also a favourite among surfers given the size of the waves normally reaching shore here. Lacking any lifeguard, the beach is considered dangerous for bathers particularly due to the strong currents on the

Estoril

Praia da Azarujinha

Beaches

Address: São João do Estoril - Cascais

Very small and sheltered by cliffs, Azarujinha Beach is located in a small cove that creates a type of natural amphitheatre. Access to the beach is by foot down a stairway beginning on the promenade which links directly with São João do Estoril

Praia da Foz do Lizandro

Beaches

Address: Ericeira - Mafra

Located on the mouth of the Lizandro river to the south of Ericeira town, operating from this beach are a range of boat excursions while children always appreciate playing in the small lagoons formed by the river. A regular destination for surfers,

Praia de São Julião

Beaches

Address: Ericeira - Mafra

Protected by tall cliffs, São Julião Beach covers a long stretch of sand that begins around 8.5 kilometres from Ericeira and extends southwards deep into Sintra council, which includes its largest extent. Ideal for long walks along the shore, the

Praia de São Sebastião

Beaches

Address: Ericeira - Mafra

To be found on the limits of Ericeira town, São Sebastião Beach owes its name to the small white chapel situated on the cliff right by the car park. The small sandy stretch all but disappears during high tide.

Right on the southern limit of Ericeira, right by a hotel, Sul Beach extends over 500 metres with each end of the Beach given over to a promenade and a range of bars and restaurants, offering the chance to taste the many traditional fish and

Located right in the centre of the town of Ericeira, Peixe (Fish) Beach, also known as Pescadores (Fishermen), is as the name suggests used by the fishing community. Throughout the summer season, this welcoming environment has a lifeguard and a

Address: São João do Estoril - Cascais
